Dear Parents / Carers

The safety and wellbeing of our children is very important to us.

I have written to you before asking you to be careful of the children at pick up and drop offs. In fact, we have agreed that the roads directly around school are for the school bus only, and should not be driven on when collecting and picking up your children. It is far safer for everyone if you park at the bottom of the road and walk your children up. This also sets a much better example to your children when thinking of their health and wellbeing and that of the entire school community.

Unfortunately some of our school community are not keeping to this agreement and, over the last few months, we have had an increasing number of cars driving all the way down to school at the key morning and afternoon drop off times. We have consulted with our local Community Police Officer for advice on this matter and we will also be using the school council, again, to remind parents in the coming term.

It is vital that the only vehicle that drives to school at this time is the school bus. There is no need for any other vehicle to be dropping off or collecting at these times.

This is advisory for the school - and is something that we as a community work on together in order to keep our children safe. I thank you in advance for your co-operation.
