



As **SCIENTISTS** we will be focusing on the human body. Starting with our teeth, we will move on to studying the digestive system as well as looking at how best to maintain good physical health.

As **WRITERS** Class 3 will start by looking at the various types of sentences and working to include a ranging variety of these in their work. In SPAG, there will be a focus on prefixes and suffixes looking at the spelling rules which surround these. Class 4 will focus on non-fiction and writing and response to our class book this half term – Brightstorm by Vashti Hardy.

As **GEOGRAPHERS** we will be learning about longitude and latitude in our map reading skills. We will be using coordinates to find a wide range of countries linking in with previous topics and the upcoming Olympic games.

In **RE** we will look at the value 'stewardship' and explore how different religions safeguard our environment and planet.

In **ICT** we will be looking at working with algorithms – the building block of code. Class 4 will also move on to developing loops and coding our robots.

Our **PSHE** we will be learning all about our bodies and how we can look after ourselves as we grow up.
