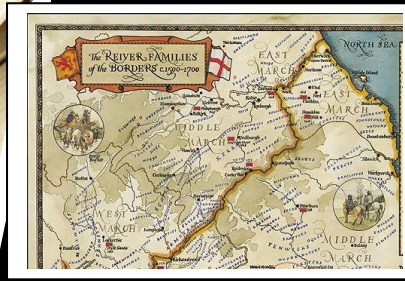
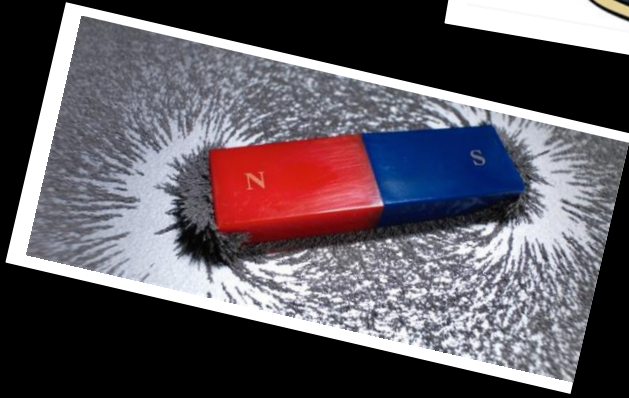
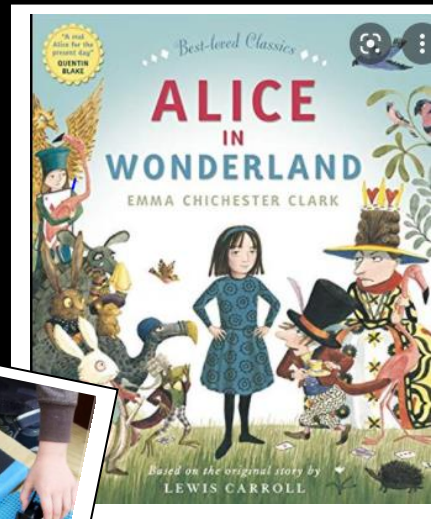


# TOPIC – 'Border Reivers'

## KEY AREAS OF LEARNING
