Individual pupil school photos will be taken on Wednesday.

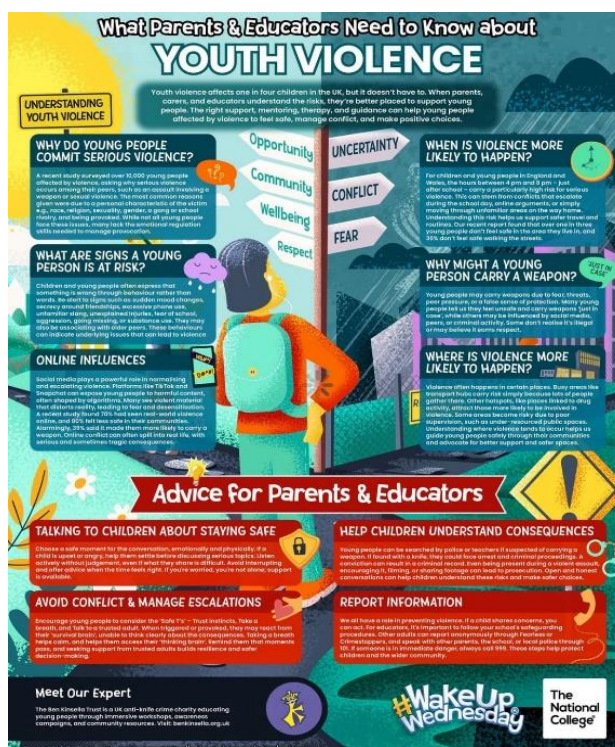

Scarlet Fever

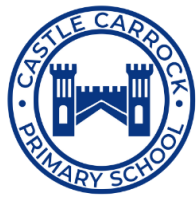
We have had a couple of confirmed cases of Scarlet Fever within school. Please see all communications sent out and to parents and if your child has symptoms, please read the guidance for further advice.

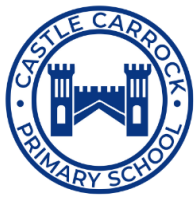
